Priyadarshini Indira Gandhi Government College for Women, situated at the heart of Haryana, Jind, is affiliated to Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind. The college has been accredited with **grade A+ in PRAYAAS by Haryana Government & Grade 'B' by NAAC**. Our college has been recognized as one of the **Colleges of Excellence** by the government of Haryana. It was established by the Government of Haryana with the noble objective of imparting quality higher education to women at a time when there was no other government college for women in the entire district. The college commenced its functioning from the academic year 2005 with the strength of 500 students and 10 faculty members offering degree in Arts and Commerce, in the P.G block's building of Government College Jind. The college was shifted in its own building in 2012. Now our college has the strength of 2695 students and 74 teaching faculty members & 26 non teaching. The college has smart classrooms with Wi-Fi facility, library, a research centre, a fully air conditioned auditorium, six science labs(physics, chemistry, botany, zoology), two Geography labs, one language lab and three Computer labs to facilitate teachers and the students with modern tools. The college currently offers B.A, B.A English Honours, B.A Geography Honours, B.Sc. Non-Medical, B.Sc. Medical, BCA, B.Com and B.Com Honours.
